

## Braxton Hebert Memorial Scholarship in Education

### General:

1. Chad and Kimberly Hebert will fund an annual \$2000 scholarship to be designated the Braxton Hebert Memorial Scholarship in Education. Chad Hebert made the initial payment for this memorial scholarship on 12 February 2008 for the academic year 2008-2009. By May 1 of each future year, the Nicholls Foundation, through the Office of Institutional Advancement, will invoice Chad Hebert for the full amount of the scholarship. Payments will be made out to the Nicholls Foundation and deposited in a special account designated the Braxton Hebert Memorial Scholarship Fund.
2. The scholarship will be awarded in the fall of 2008. The amount of the award will be \$1000 a semester.
3. The dean of the College of Education will appoint a committee from the college to select the recipient in accordance with the criteria outlined below. Chad Hebert or his designee will serve on the committee. The dean will notify Chad Hebert of the initial meeting in a timely manner.
4. This scholarship will be advertised through the Nicholls media, including the university web site and the *Nicholls Worth*.

### Criteria

1. The recipient will be a fulltime student enrolled in a degree program in the College of Education
2. The recipient will be classified as either a sophomore, junior, or senior.
3. The recipient will have earned a 3.25 grade point average or higher at the time of the award.
4. The recipient shall hold the scholarship for two consecutive semesters. To receive the scholarship for a second semester, the recipient must maintain a 3.25 grade point average.
5. Primary consideration must go to a resident of Louisiana. Should there not be a qualified applicant from Louisiana, the scholarship may be awarded to any other student who meets the criteria.
